



Overnight Campout for SIT 1s

As part of our leadership program, we take the SIT 1s on an overnight campout offsite. Traditionally this is a highlight of the program and, oftentimes, campers say it was their favorite part of the session. We will take the girls to a private youth camping area at Pedernales Falls State Park, located between Dripping Springs and Johnson City (about 45 minutes from Wimberley). It is a large primitive site with water spigots and a composting toilet. The girls will set up and sleep in tents, hike, cook dinner over coals, swim in the river (if the water levels are safe) and make lots of memories! Our plan is to leave around 3:00 on the middle Sunday of the camp session and return to RRR on Monday morning before 9:00 class.

The girls will have all the necessary items if they use our regular camp packing list. The only additional item suggested is a sleeping bag (or other extra bedding) designated for this adventure. They can certainly use the bedding from their camp bunk, but it is also nice to have extra in case it gets dirty.

Their SIT moms will accompany them along with one of the camp directors. While there, they will remain in contact with the office at Rocky River. They will be traveling in camp vehicles with drivers over 21 years of age who have completed camp's driver training program.
